Dress code at ALL Almond club day events.

(Boots, hoods, jods and hair are usually the worst offences!)

At Almond Club Days whether taking part in **any training sessions** or **competing in SJ or Dressage classes** later in the day if in doubt **the dress code is - smart competition dress but without your show jacket.**

Please can everyone read the guidelines below - .

Jods - Cream / beige/ white jods or breeches.

Tshirts - Short or long sleeved - no vest tops

Sweatshirt – no hoodies

Waistcoat - optional

Riding boots please – long or short riding boots or short boots and gaiters but NO yard or country boots or wellies

Hair – in hairnet if shoulder length or longer. Even if hair is already in a pony tail or plait - for health and safety it should also be in a hair net and / or bun!

Gloves (any colour don't need to be white!) are required for dressage and recommended for SJ.

Riding Hats - Hard hats with 3 point harness and marked to current safety standards must be worn at all times when riding.

****** Persistent dress code offenders will not be allowed to take part on the day including training sessions.
